Course 11 - Aroma and Bouquet Practical Knowledge

Aromas versus Bouquet. To put it even more simply, while it is true that there are three main aromas in wines, only the primary and secondary aromas qualify as "aromas" in wine lingo; the tertiary aroma is referred to as "bouquet." That, in a nutshell is the difference between aromas and bouquet.

Aroma vs. bouquet A common aroma associated with the grape variety Gewürztraminer is that of lychee fruit. In professional wine tasting, there is generally a distinction made between "aromas" and a wine's "bouquet" while in casual wine tasting these two terms are used interchangeably.

By using further procedures such as aroma extract dilution analysis (AEDA), the odorants with the highest odor impact can be ascertained. Furthermore, implementation of techniques such as stable isotope dilution analysis (SIDA) allow odorants at trace levels to be precisely quantified.
